# COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

*2021-2022*

- ★ The following protocols were developed using recommendations and requirements from the Marion County Public Health Department, the Indiana Department of Health, and are subject to change.
- ★ School Town of Speedway follows the guidelines of the Marion County Public Health Department which requires us to have some varied protocols from districts in neighboring counties.

## **MASKS and FACE COVERINGS**

- Masks are optional for all Speedway staff members and students.
- Masks are required while riding the bus for all students (grades PK-12) and adults, per federal mandate.
- Masks are required in the nurse's office.

## **ISOLATION**

- Students/Staff that test positive for COVID will need to isolate for 5 days. They may return to school on day 6 if fever free for 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medication.

## **CLASSROOMS and CAFETERIAS**

- Students will be spread out in classrooms and the cafeteria to maximum distance where feasible.
- Students should bring a personal water bottle labeled with their name that may be refilled at filling stations.
- Sharing of any classroom materials is discouraged.
- Student desks will be faced in the same direction when feasible.

## **CLEANING and DISINFECTING**

- High-touch areas will continue to be disinfected frequently.
- Teachers and staff will continue to use sanitizer and cleaning products as needed throughout the day.



Beginning on August 3rd, 2021 ParentSquare will be the primary communication link with Speedway Schools. It will be the primary tool all of our schools will use to keep you informed about your student and what is happening in their school, including COVID-19 notifications. The first step is to download the ParentSquare app to your iPhone or Android device. You will receive an email to activate your account on August 3rd, 2021.
