COVID-19 Update

Speedway Schools does not have any new COVID-19 cases to report since the last update, 9/1/2020. The current total of confirmed cases remains at three (3) since the beginning of the school year. We will continue to work with the Marion County Public Health Department and Indiana State Health Department to contact trace and collaboratively make decisions.

Instruction

Speedway Schools strongly believes that face-to-face instruction is the best way to learn. If you want to transition your student (K-8) from E-Learning to in-person, we would welcome that request. Please contact your child(s) building principal.

Food Services

Due to a recently issued nationwide USDA waiver for School Nutrition Programs, all students will qualify to receive FREE reimbursable meals starting Sept 10th. As part of the Families First Coronavirus Response Act, this waiver is based on the exceptional circumstances of the public health emergency and supports access to nutritious meals while maintaining student safety.

This waiver is effective until December 31st, 2020 or until Federal funds are depleted (whichever comes first).

This applies to a reimbursable meal only. All a la carte sale pricing will remain the same.

A reimbursable meal includes choices from 5 food groups; grains, protein, milk, fruit, and vegetable. A student must select a minimum of 3 of these and must include a fruit or vegetable.
